

About Cube Foundation

Cube Foundation is a registered non-profit charity that has operated at a grassroots level within a deprived area of Sheffield since first being established in 2002, and was one of the first in Sheffield to educate people about Islam in a post-9/11 era.

Since then it has also organised community litter picks, food drives to feed the homeless, and numerous fundraising events in the local area.

In 2012 it bought a building to operate from for £88,000, and required a further £27,000 in renovations. With the help of many community donors, it was able to secure the total of £115,000 as a qardh-al-hasan (interest-free loan) from the community.

Since being purchased and renovated, the Cube Foundation building has functioned as both the charity's office and the hub from which all of its projects have been launched.

The building is home to Lote Tree Academy - the Cube Foundation's educational wing - which holds twice-daily classes from Monday to Friday with the goal of teaching young boys and girls to read Qur'an in a nurturing and abuse-free environment.

To date, £80,000 of the original £115,000 loan has been repaid to donors, leaving just £35,000 remaining to be repaid.

By sponsoring me to climb Mount Snowdon for the Cube Foundation, you will be helping to bring this number even further down, freeing up the charity's funds to be used elsewhere in projects that can more directly benefit the surrounding community, as well as potentially partaking in the reward of the Cube Foundation's many projects for as long as the building is used, Insha'Allah.

What else the Cube Foundation does?

The Cube Foundation is a registered UK charity with a 100% donation policy, ensuring that 100% of the money that you donate is given to your desired project without the deduction of any administration fees.

Its other projects include the Truth About Islam Project (TAIP), a da'wah initiative with the goal of engaging the general public and educating them about Islam. To this end, TAIP has organised visits to schools and hosted a weekly stall in Sheffield City Centre since 2002, which has seen over 50 British people embrace Islam through its efforts.

Outside of teaching hours, Lote Tree Academy's classrooms host regular events and courses for adults on a range of Islamic subjects, including tajweed (Qur'anic pronunciation) and tafseer (Qur'anic exegesis), in addition to secular subjects like the Arabic, Urdu and Bengali languages.

In 2016, the Cube Foundation travelled to Azad Kashmir in Pakistan in order to establish a sponsorship programme for orphans and widows with no financial providers, and is currently facilitating the sponsoring of 5 widows and 16 orphans.

Cube Mount Snowdon Challenge 2019 - Guidelines for Participants

Date of trek: **25th August 2019**

How much is Registration Fee?

A £30 registration fee is required to confirm your seat. As seats are limited we cannot guarantee a seat without the registration fee. The registration fee is **Non-refundable** once paid even if you don't go. It is to cover transport to and from Mount Snowdon and packed lunch, Certificates, Medals, Trophies etc. (it does not however cover the train up Mount Snowdon if you so wished to use it). Sandwiches and drinks will be provided but you are also welcome to bring along your own.

The registration fee can be handed into the cube foundation office during office opening times (mon-fri 4pm to 6pm Sundays 10:30am to 1:30pm) also pick up your sponsor form and guidelines.

Can children take part in this event?

Not on this occasion. This trek is for brothers and sisters but no children or young people under 17 years of age are allowed to take part for safety reasons.

Do I need to raise a minimum amount to take part?

No there is no minimum limit of funds to raise to take part although the more you raise the more we will be able to pay back qardh-hassana (loan) for our centre building and the more reward you will get in terms of the activities that take place at our centre. Also there will be a first prize and second and third prize for raising the most amount :)

Prizes, Trophies, Medals and Certificates

***1st prize** (for most amount raised) : Brand new Samsung J4plus phone courtesy of S9 Communication Darnall, Sheffield AND 'Top Lad' or 'Top Lass' Winner's Trophy.

***2nd prize** (for 2nd most amount raised): £100 Meadow hall voucher AND runner up trophy.

***3rd prize** (for 3rd most amount raised): Gift Hamper courtesy of Iqra Lifestyle Store Attercliffe, Sheffield AND runner up Trophy.

*All those who complete the whole trek up and back down the Mount will receive the '**Finisher**' Medal.

*All participants will receive a **certificate of participation** regardless of amount raised or having completed the trek.

Where does the money I raised go?

All money raised will go towards paying off the remaining debt on the Cube Foundation Centre building. Cube Foundation is a UK registered charity (charity no. 1150120) that has been running various projects since it was set up in 2002. Are there any toilet facilities on Mount Snowdon?

Yes, there is a shop at the top of Mount Snowdon with tea, coffee facilities. There are toilets at the base and at the top of Mount Snowdon. However, once reaching the top of the mountain, please do not waste time as we have to get back on bus for a certain time as otherwise **the coach may leave without you**. Coach departure time and return will be given on the whatsapp group when we have confirmed. The coach will take around 3 hours to reach Mount Snowdon and around the same amount of time to come back to Sheffield. The time to climb up is on average 3 hours and around the same amount of time to climb back down. We would advise those interested to start walking regularly to build up their fitness level if you are not used to walking long distances or uphill. Please wear

suitable footwear and clothing on the day.
